## 2.009 Pink Team Code of Conduct

The 2.009 Pink Team shall uphold the following principles:

- I. Conduct: Team members shall respect each other, their workspace, and themselves.
  - > Team members shall maintain a positive attitude and stay on task during meetings.

  - Team members shall communicate all thoughts and information in an honest and professional manner. All that is said shall be considered respectfully.
  - > Team members shall take responsibility for what components he/she can reasonably accomplish within the time frame and to the standards expected. If a task cannot be completed, he/she will tell the rest of the team and seek a solution quickly.
  - All meetings and research shall be documented via notes, photos, videos, agendas, minutes, and emails. These shall be uploaded on the team site (PM or Google Drive).
- IV. Decision-Making: All decisions shall be transparent and well-informed for the benefit of the team and the project as a whole.
  - > The team shall make decisions by collective discussions considering objective data, experience, and knowledge. Resulting agreements shall be made clear at the end of discussion and documented in writing. If consensus cannot be reached in a reasonable time, then a majority vote will be taken to make a decision.

- V. Leadership: All leaders shall fulfill the responsibilities of their respective positions to meet the needs of the team.
  - > System Integrators shall set appropriate deadlines, set team objectives to meet those deadlines, delegate tasks to team members, organize team meetings, write lab agendas, and follow-up report, hold teammates accountable, communicate with each other and mentors.
  - Task force leaders will follow the above with respect to their task forces.
  - All team officers shall submit a weekly update to System Integrators.
  - ➤ All team members shall also consider themselves leaders on their own tasks. Therefore, they shall take the initiative to work on those tasks, and make decisions relating to those tasks, until they are completed.
- VI. Respect for Partners: Team members will initiate and maintain positive and respectful relationships with outside partners.
  - ➤ Team members shall interact respectfully with all outside partners, including mentors, TA's and clients. It is the responsibility of the team member to initiate requests with outside partners for information or advice, and they should conduct all communication in a timely and polite manner.
